

## Dragon Law Payment Terms

### 1 Payment terms

- 1.1 This is a legally binding document which sets out how you will pay for Dragon Law. We've tried to make this as clear as possible, but if you don't understand our Payment Terms, or require further information before agreeing to them, then you should speak to your contact person at Dragon Law or contact us via Live Chat or email [service@dragonlaw.io](mailto:service@dragonlaw.io).
- 1.2 Our services are subscription-based and you must subscribe to Dragon Law for at least one year. However, there are two different ways you can pay for your subscription: once a month, or once a year.

### 2 Monthly payments – pay once a month

- 2.1 We think it's easiest for you to pay for your subscription on a month-by-month basis (**Monthly Payments**). However, we still need your commitment to pay your monthly fee for at least twelve (12) months, so this is a legally binding agreement that you will.
- 2.2 By subscribing to Monthly Payments, you explicitly authorise Dragon Law to charge the applicable recurring fees to your credit card. There may also be a one-off *onboarding* fee at the start of your subscription.
- 2.3 **The Term:** Your subscription to Dragon Law will start on the subscription start date and last for twelve (12) months. Unless you notify Dragon Law in writing of your decision to terminate your plan at least thirty (30) days before the end of the Term, your subscription will automatically continue to renew at the end of the Term on a monthly basis at the then-current monthly fee.
- 2.4 If you decide to cancel before the end of the Term, you will be liable for a Cancellation Fee. The Cancellation Fee is calculated as the monthly fee multiplied by the number of months you have left in the Term.
- 2.5 It is important you understand that although you pay monthly, your subscription is for a minimum term of twelve (12) months.
- 2.6 Each charge applies to the subscription period immediately following the charge date (i.e. the calendar month immediately following the charge date).

### 3 Annual payment – pay once a year

- 3.1 If you have opted to pay for your Dragon Law subscription annually in advance (**Annual Payment**) your credit card will be charged on the first day of your subscription, and on the anniversary of your payment you will be charged again.
- 3.2 By subscribing to Annual Payment, you explicitly authorise Dragon Law to charge the applicable recurring fees to your credit card.
- 3.3 **The Term:** Your subscription to Dragon Law will start on the subscription start date and last for twelve (12) months. Unless you notify Dragon Law in writing of your decision to terminate your plan, your subscription will automatically renew at the end of that Term for a further Term of twelve (12) months at the then-current

annual fee.

- 3.4 Each charge applies to the subscription period immediately following the charge date (i.e. the calendar year immediately following the charge date).

#### 4 **Your details**

- 4.1 You must keep your credit card details up to date to avoid any interruption to your service.
- 4.2 You may update any of your billing information (including a change to you credit card) through the app; or by contacting Dragon Law directly by Live Chat or by email on [service@dragonlaw.io](mailto:service@dragonlaw.io).

#### 5 **Changes to these payment terms**

We may amend these Payment Terms from time to time in our sole discretion without notice or liability to you. It is your responsibility to review these Payment Terms periodically. By continuing to use our services following such amendments to the Payment Terms, you agree to be bound by such amendments. If you do not agree to the Payment Terms, now or at any time, please do not use our site, applications, subscription plans or any of our services which are subject to payment.

#### 6 **Dispute resolution**

Dragon Law and you agree to arbitrate all disputes and claims pursuant to the Terms of Service.
